



In 2009, after producing the Colts seventh consecutive season with 10+ victories, Dungy announced his retirement as an NFL head coach. He currently appears as an NFL television analyst on NBC's *Football Night In America*, and remains active in many community and charitable organizations including *All-Pro Dad*, a family based organization.

Dungy will also serve as keynote speaker for the event.

Taliaferro, an All-American halfback and quarterback, led Indiana to its only undefeated Big Ten Conference Championship in the late 1940s. He was picked by the Chicago Bears in the 1949 NFL draft, but chose to play instead with the Los Angeles Dons of the All-American Football Conference. He later moved to the NFL, where he played with the New York Yanks, Dallas Texans, Baltimore Colts and Philadelphia Eagles. He was inducted into the College Football Hall of Fame in 1981.
