Dye won the 1978 and 1979 United States Senior Women's Amateur Golf Championships as well as two Canadian Senior Women's Championships.

Known as the "First Lady" of golf architecture in the United States, she and her course building partner are famous for their design of THE PLAYERS Championship at Sawgrass, located in Jacksonville, Florida.

Alice Dye is a member of the Indiana Golf Hall of Fame and recipient of the PGA's First Lady of Golf Award. Pete and Alice Dye continue to reside in Carmel, IN.

The Keynote speaker for the 2011 Brady Sports Achievement awards is also no stranger to the world of golf. Top professional instructor Hank Haney is known for coaching Tiger Woods and major championship winner Mark O'Meara.

Haney's work has most recently been featured on the popular *Golf Channel* program, *The Haney Project*, where he has worked on helping celebrities like Charles Barkley, Ray Romano and Rush Limbaugh with their golf swings.
