G. Peter Maiers II, M.D., Inducted into the American Academy of Orthopaedic Surgeons

Peter Maiers II, M.D., an orthopedic surgeon with Methodist Sports Medicine / The Orthopedic Specialists was inducted as a Fellow of the American Academy of Orthopaedic Surgeons (AAOS) on February 15, 2011, during ceremonies at the Academy's 2011 Annual Meeting in San Diego. Dr. Maiers was one of 667 new members inducted.

Fellowship trained at the Cincinnati Sports Medicine and Orthopedic Center, Dr. Maiers specializes in sports medicine with a special emphasis on treatment of disorders of the hip and knee. Utilizing techniques developed for the competitive athlete, Dr. Maiers applies the principles of individualized treatment plans and a team approach to all of his patients. A graduate of Indiana University and the Indiana University School of Medicine, Dr. Maiers is a member of the American Orthopedic Society of Sports Medicine, the Arthroscopy Association of North America and the International Society of Hip Arthroscopy. He is currently conducting research on arthroscopic treatment of hip impingement and arthroscopic treatment of ACL injuries. Dr. Maiers frequently lectures on non arthritic hip disease and instructs other surgeons on arthroscopic surgical techniques in the hip.
