



## Specialist to be inducted into hall of fame

Dr. Arthur C. Rettig, founding partner of Methodist Sports Medicine/The Orthopedic Specialists, will be inducted into the Indiana Football Coaches Association Hall of Fame on June 17.

The induction will honor a career spent devoted to the game of football in Indiana as orthopedic consultant and head team physician for the Indianapolis Colts; Indiana University - Purdue University Indianapolis; Cathedral High School for many years; and North Central High School, where his sons Lance and Brad went to school and played sports.

"It's very unusual for someone other than college and high school players and coaches to receive this award, but Dr. Rettig

deserves to be recognized for being an outstanding individual who has been dedicated to football in Indiana and very influential in this community for more than 25 years," Paul Loggan, assistant athletics director and past president of the Indiana Football Coaches Association, said in a press release. "I can't say enough about the man."

In 2003, Rettig received the Jerry "Hawk" Rhea award given annually by the Professional Football Athletic Trainers Society to an NFL physician for outstanding service to NFL Players and the NFL Physician's Society. He was co-recipient of the Indiana State Medical Association's Commission on Sports Medicine 2003 Team Physician of the Year Award.
