

**Colts' DB Bethea helps provide shoes for the homeless**



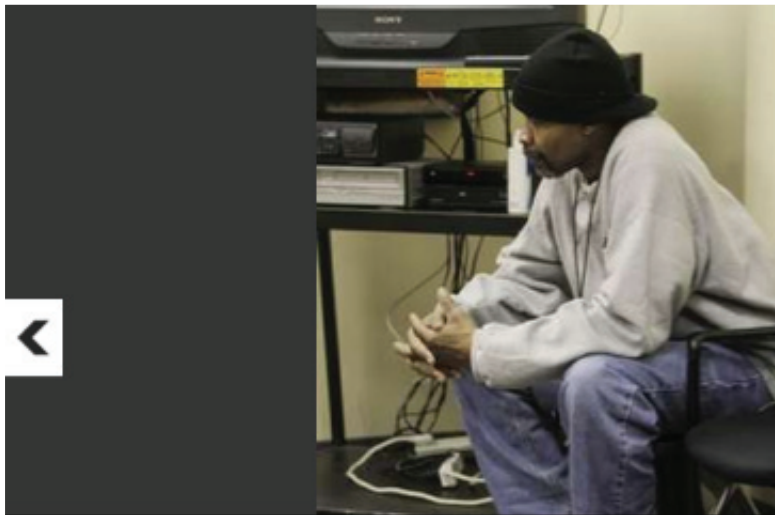
